- 1) Funding for international Shakespeare tour
 - a) FAR, AT, LM and Ros met with the producers this morning
 - b) They have provided a statement saying what the money will be used for transportation costs for students to get to the venues
 - c) The VC's office has stated that they will only fund the tour through OUDS account
 - d) It is also noted than on the survey responses which we have recently received that Edinburgh tours are very expensive and we do not fund transportation for those tours. We should have more continuity.
 - i) Last years' fringe funding was explicitly contingent on not budgeting for transport or accommodation.
 - ii) The National Tour only receives a pro-rata loan from OUDS although they do get money from the VC for accommodation
 - iii) We cannot afford to provide accommodation or transport for any other tour this is for individual colleges to do
 - (1) It is noted than in a future meeting we should discuss the possibility of providing for students in financial need
 - e) The funding of any drama productions at all was curtailed by the VCs office and was only re-instated by a letter to VC from senior members on the basis of funding of accommodation in the same way as sports teams
 - f) We are in partnership with Thelma Holt on this tour but we have not been allowed to view the budget, although the the VC's office have been given it
 - g) We worry that the tour is not accessible to the whole drama community
 - h) Our previous offer was rejected on the basis that it was not useful for the production to only fund on the basis of receipts
 - Vote to restate the offer of £750 on the condition that OUDS has billing and the budget is shared with the Treasurer and Senior Treasurer confidentially with the approval of the London Office
