JB: Waiting on Exeter, Pembroke, Regent's. Another notice will go out in the newsletter. CW: Do you want to run an event? JB: Yes, I can book a room in Corpus. I'll run a meeting so that people can find out what it's about and get them together to meet each other.

#### FRESHERS

BE: I'm keen to get workshops going. GF: Ell and I thought it would be good to have lots of workshops after cuppers in the 2<sup>nd</sup> half of Michaelmas. BE: Hilary term shows will advertise at end of Michaelmas. There's a difference between those who will do cuppers for fun and those who are serious about drama. GM: There needs to be two slots. I think second half of Michaelmas is more important. CV: People come out of cuppers and want to do something but then want to do more. Is it just the way the system works? GF: What's the likelihood of Fresher's signing up for Hilary shows? CV: It would be good to do something in early Hilary. GF: But we want to keep the momentum up. BE: The people at Oxford are the people who are good at doing multiple things. Freshers are not fragile. GF: A lot of it is who you know. People need to socialise and network. BE: I envisaged the monologue workshops to be bi-termly. Even if the first few have bad attendance it will build up. One-off workshops are really scary.

JT: We need to discuss the way shows audition before they know if they've got a venue.

CV: As soon as one show auditions, then everyone does. GF/CB: Can we talk to the O'Reilly about the new rules/weeks that they have available? JB: My understanding is that it's financial. GF: People are under the impression that if they've already cast, the bids will be more successful. CB: Their policy has changed. They can't mention who they have cast. CV: Can we ask the O'Reilly to have earlier bids. BE: Can we have Term A Term B? CV: You can push back casting until 6<sup>th</sup> or 7<sup>th</sup>. Interviews just need to be a week earlier. CW: Information needs to go out for bids earlier. BE: If you're bidding for Michaelmas 7<sup>th</sup> week you won't have your act together by Michaelmas. CV: It's a financial decision not an artistic decision. CB: It's not that standards will slip, but it's about what people can actually achieve. CW: We need to start a dialogue with Ell and Keble.
